3 REASONS WHY You Should Never Put Off Dental Work

- 2. Treatment Costs More:** As dental problems gets worse, so does the extent of treatment and its cost. A filling turns into a root canal. Bone loss from one lost tooth causes another lost tooth, both of which now need to be replaced. Gum disease, ignored, may require oral surgery to remedy. The plain fact is that it's less expensive to treat dental problems early.
- 3. Life Is Unpleasant:** As dental problems escalate, they can start to cause other problems. This results in a lower quality of life, embarrassment and pain. Why suffer needlessly? The solution is often easier than people think.

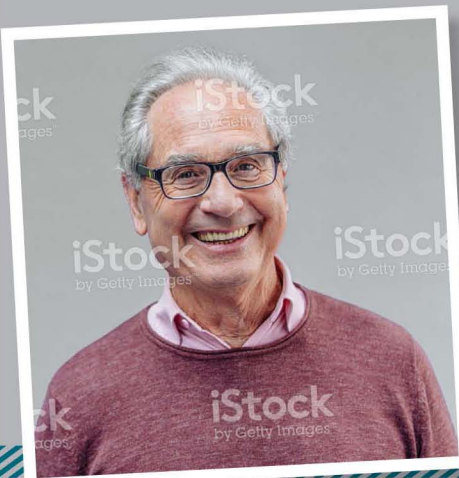
